Dear Ma'am

I would like to take this opportunity to invite your school to our annual Netball Week in Stellenbosch (Bloemhof High School), Cape Town. Next year will be our eight tournament.

- **WORLD SPORTS EVENTS BLOEMHOF HIGH SCHOOL NETBALL WEEK (STELLENBOSCH)** for U/12A-, u/13A-, u/15A1- and A2-, u/16A1- and A2- and u/19A1- and A2 teams from Friday the 1st of April 2011 until Wednesday the 6th of April 2011.



Our tournament is particularly popular amongst school's that would like their different age groups to tour together, to ensure preparation for the upcoming season. The tournament also makes provision for teams to compete against each other on equal footing, as well as contending for the principle of strength versus strength.

Matches will be played against teams from different provinces. The match on the 2nd of April will be determined before hand, however the matches on the 4th and 6th of April will be determined by a committee, based on the outcome of each previous match day's results. Matches will take place on Saturday the 2nd of April, Monday the 4th of April and Wednesday the 6th of April. Each team will play 5 matches during the tournament.

The teams will arrive on Friday the 1st of April. On Sunday, April 3rd and Tuesday the 5th of April, the schools are free to pursue their own programmes.

Since 2006, we have been extremely successful in combining a school's sport tour with an educational tour. As a result, many schools tend to stay longer to visit a few historic places in and around Cape Town, such as The Castle, Robben Island, Table Mountain and Simons Town to mention a few. It is therefore possible to add a learning experience to your sport tour.

Number of touring individuals

Teams consist of 12 individuals: 10 players and 2 coaches. Extra staff or players are however welcome; simply arrange in advance. You pay per undertaking the tour.

Parents

We can also provide accommodation for parents who wish to join the tour. They must, however, arrange this with us in advance.

Every school/team is responsible for their own transport. Please feel free to contact us, if for example assistance is required in arranging a bus for the week. If you are planning on flying down to Cape Town, we would like to emphasise the importance of making early bookings and arrangements for special tariffs via the airline companies.

Prize giving

On Tuesday evening, the 5th of April a compulsory prize giving will be held. Standard Bank will make use of this opportunity to award prizes to players. During this time we will also announce the player of the tournament as well as the selected u/15-, u/16 and u/19-teams and coaches for the overseas tour.

Overseas tour

The teams chosen in 2010 will tour England in December. Please see our webpage for information about this. Next year we will also choose a u/15-, u/16-, and u/19- team. Each team will be allocated two coaches. All the **coaches’ expenses are covered, i.e. free**; however the players’ expenses are not. Just as with all other tours, the **players are responsible for their own expenses**. We will provide the match kit etc. Each team will be consist of 12 players and two coaches.

It is indeed a privilege for each player and coach to be selected. We are planning on touring to Australia or New Zealand in 2011. If we manage to organise the tour within three months after the tournament; we would very much like to go during the Rugby World Cup.

Referees

From 2011, referees will be available for ‘hire’ for your matches. If you choose not to use this option, it is your responsibility to provide a qualified referee for each team for the duration of the Netball Week. It is **compulsory** for each team to provide a qualified, competent referee.

Accommodation and meals

Teams have the option of staying at hostels in either: Durbanville (30 km from Stellenbosch), Kuilsriver, Franschoek (20 km from Stellenbosch), Paarl, Strand (15km from Stellenbosch) and Stellenbosch itself. In Stellenbosch however, we can only accommodate 300 girls in hostels. **Please visit our webpage at www.worldsporttours.com and click on “accommodation” to view the available facilities.**

Breakfast and dinner will be enjoyed at your place of accommodation. Lunch however, will not be provided unless otherwise stated. Please note that you have the choice of which package you would prefer.

In Short

The Sports Week ends on Wednesday, April 6th at 17h00, therefore please keep this in mind when making your tour arrangements. All teams cannot play early in the morning on the last day of the tour. Please make travel arrangements for after 17:00 on the last day.

The welcoming on Friday, April 1st at 20h00 is compulsory for all coaches. Here, the rules of the tournament will be provided. The official opening is on Saturday morning; all players and coaches must be present.

All courts will be equipped with competent medical services, court co-ordinators and selectors. From 2011, it will be compulsory for all teams to bring proof of identity along with them to the tournament; i.e. a copy of their birth certificate and photo or id. This is to ensure the safety of the players.

A function for the coaches will be held on Saturday the 2nd of April.

Lists of each team must be given to the selectors at the field before each match. These lists will be provided. After Saturday and Monday's matches, all coaches are to meet briefly at 18h00 to determine the following day's matches.

Coaching Clinic (Additional / not compulsory)

METHODS OF PAYMENT

Please plan your tour timeously and allow parents sufficient time for payment. It is important to note that registration and the following deposits per team are payable on the following dates to ensure your place in the 2011 tournament. Also note that the hostels will only be booked once the **deposit** has been paid. If the hostels are fully booked, you can only make use of the other available accommodation facilities. Therefore, teams that have paid **both deposits** by November 2010 will have first choice of where they will stay. **No deposit is refundable, should a team decide to withdraw or cancel their tour.**

 On 1 March 2011 (last payment) - All outstanding amounts to be paid in full (All teams)
