School Hours

The official school hours are 08:00 - 12:15. The gate is opened at 07:45 every morning to accommodate working parents. Please note that the classrooms are out of bounds until this time. Even though the educators get there earlier, they need time to prepare their classrooms without interruptions from excited little people or having to attend to injuries. Learners must be at school no later than 08:15 so as not to disrupt school routine. Please collect your child promptly at 12:15 because the classrooms have to be prepared for the After School Centre.

We follow Kenridge Primary School's calendar. School starts on Wednesday, 11 January 2012. For the first two weeks the hours will be shorter to give our new learners a chance to adjust to the school morning.

1 st week	:	08:00 - 11:00	(11 January - 13 January)
2 nd week	:	08:00 - 11:30	(16 January - 20 January)
3 rd week & onwards	:	08:00 - 12:15	(23 January - December)

Money Matters

Your account will be debited with R65,00 on 1 March and 1 August respectively to cover the cost of baking requirements, a flip file and message book. If at any stage you are required to issue a cheque to us, it **MUST** be made out to **Kenridge Primary**. A note of any money sent to school must be made in the message book. The teacher's signature against this will indicate receipt thereof.

Parking

Access to our classes is from the large car park off Lower Tygerbergvalley Road. Please ensure that the gate is always closed behind you. Driving into the school grounds is not permitted.

Requirements for 1st day:

- A rigid plastic suitcase, **A3** in size or a 3 division Junior briefcase is required. Bags, rucksacks and pull-alongs are not allowed.
- The message book should please be covered in attractive paper. Place the supplied label in the top left hand corner and then cover the book with contact.
- Please supply 2 identical face cloths: **EMBROIDERED** with the child's full name and first letter of the surname. They also need a short, strong hanging loop. Please prepare your child for leaving these at school.
- Please also send 2 bars (100g) of soap for washing hands.
- A change of clothing in case of spills: a set of old clothes in a zip-lock type bag and clearly marked. Please remember to replace clothes used and substitute for change of seasons.
- A healthy teatime snack.

Snack Time

Please remember that this is a tea time snack and not a main lunch. The emphasis is on teaching healthy eating habits.

We suggest brown bread sandwiches, plain Marie or Tennis biscuits, bran muffins, fresh fruit and vegetables, nuts, cheese, viennas, biltong or dried fruit. Contents of mini packets must be pre-empted into lunch boxes.

The following are not allowed:

- Cakes (including chocolate muffins), sweets, Super C's, Tinkies, any biscuits with sweet fillings.
- Yoghurt, fizzy drinks or fizzy flavoured water.
- Flasks or any bottle that does not have a tight, screw on lid.

Other requirements:

- NO toys may be brought to school. Theme related stories are always welcome, as too are children's music and story tapes.
- "Bare foot is best!" If, however, your child needs to wear something to school please ensure that it is sandals, slops or Wellington boots. It is a Fledgling rule that at no time during the year may lace-ups be worn to school (children in this age group cannot easily manage their own laces).
- T-shirts and tracksuits are available from the school shop. These T-shirts must be worn on all school outings and on Thursdays. Tracksuits are the winter outing uniform. Contact the shop (☎ 021 976 3046) for prices and availability.
- Wellington boots are compulsory for wet and cold weather.
