Use bullet points to separate the facts.</p> <p>2.2 Many of the words at the end of the lines in the poem, rhyme. List ten pairs of rhyming couplets. Here are examples of the first two rhyming words (couplets) in the poem: learned/concerned. That is a rhyming couplet. Now you find your own ten couplets (in other words, write down twenty words).</p>

	<p>2.3 In your <u>English Booklet</u>, turn to page 50. “What is a Simile?” Revise what a simile is and look at the 20 examples.</p> <p>At the bottom it refers to Metaphors – <u>you can ignore that instruction for the time being</u>.</p> <p>Frame page 50 and <u>underline all the similes in green</u>. Eg, the first simile on the page is number 1 – <u>as fresh as a daisy</u>. That should be underlined in green.</p> <p>Now listen to the poem once more and find one SIMILE that is used in the poem.</p> <p>Write it down in your English workbook next to number 2.3.</p> <p>Please rule off as shown in the demonstration.</p> <p>Click on the LINK IN THE MEMO FOLDER for possible answers</p>
