## ENROLMENT 2022: GRADE 1 - 7

- All Public Schools are required to adhere to the WCED admission time frames.
  School admissions open on Friday, 26 February 2021 and close on Friday, 26 March 2021.
  Parents must use the following website address, <a href="https://admissions.westerncape.gov.za">https://admissions.westerncape.gov.za</a>, to apply on-line and follow the application up with a hard copy, submitted to the enrolment officer at the school, within 14 days of application.
  - 2. It is our pleasure to make the Application Package for admission to our school available to parents. Please click on the Application Package, print all of the relevant documents (Admission Form, Debit Order Form, Financial Undertaking and Visual Screening Form). Complete, sign and attach all of the necessary documentation. Hand all of the forms from the Application Package to the enrolment officer at the school. Enrolment will only be considered once all of the necessary documentation has been received.
- 3. The completed Application Package must be handed to the enrolment officer at the school from 26 February 2021 and not later than 26 March 2021. You will receive written notification of your child's acceptance into Kenridge Primary School by **28 May 2021**. All applications received after 26 March 2021, will be placed on a waiting list. Only available spaces will then be filled.
- 4. Due to the extent of the school's feeder community and developments within this area, the school can ONLY accommodate learners who permanently reside within the school's feeder community. Should you live outside any of these residential areas, your application will be placed on a waiting list. Enrolments in this instance are subject to vacancies in the respective classes. These areas are Kenridge, Durbell, Durbanville Hills, De Bron, Doordekraal, Welgemoed North, Protea Valley, Kanonberg, Welgedacht, Van Riebeeckshof and Oude Westhof.
- 5. **Financial obligation**:
- 5.1 School Fees (School Account): Kenridge Primary School is a fee-paying school, with school fees as determined by the School Governing Body each year. At present (2021) the fees are R 23 470,00 per child per annum and are payable at the beginning of each year. A concession is granted by the School Governing Body which allows for these fees to be paid over a ten-month period by means of a debit order (1 February 1 November). Payment of school fees is further subject to the School Fee Collection Policy. School fees for 2022 will be determined at a budget meeting which will be held towards the end of this year.
- 5.2 Menu and Charge Form (Trust Account): Detailed information regarding the Menu and Charge Form as well as levies and choice of extra-mural activities, will be available on Orientation Day. The levies for menu activities are revised at the end of every year. Parents are obliged to pay all levies in advance by means of the school's debit order system. Should a levy be amended, your debit order will automatically be adjusted. (In the event of such an adjustment, parents will be notified in writing).
- 6. Should your application be successful, you and your child will be invited to spend an Orientation Day with us at our school. Further information regarding your Orientation Day and preparation for the new year will be included in your acceptance letter.
