Level 1 swimmers can stay Level 1, but they are also welcome to be reassessed for Level 2 if they feel they have improved sufficiently.

If you are unable to attend your allocated time-slot, please make arrangements with Mrs Du Plessis to attend the Thursday afternoon (extra) session.

The swimmers with the top eight times recorded at the time-trials for each particular event, will qualify to swim in these finals at the Interhouse Gala. Letters will be sent out via email to the finalists on Wednesday, 24 January. The A and B relay teams for the first term will be chosen from the Interhouse 25m results, with the exception of the U/12 and U/13 age-groups, which swim 50 m events at the gala. U/12 & U/13 25m trials will be on Monday, 22 January in their practice session from 15:30-16:15, and on Thursday, 25 January from 14:30-15:30 to select their relay teams.

Our <u>KENRIDGE INTERHOUSE CHAMPIONSHIP GALA</u> will take place on Thursday, 1 February at 14:30. We hope to finish by 17:15. The gala takes preference over other school sport on this day.

All swimmers must wear a plain black swimming costume (black jammers are allowed for the boys) and a KPS green or house colour cap. No other coloured caps or club caps are allowed.

The points will be awarded as follows:

1st place: 10 points 2nd place: 8 points 3rd place: 6 points 4th place: 4 points 5th place: 2 points

6th - 8th place: 1 point each.



Medals will be awarded for the first three places in each event.
