



UNIFORM FOR GRADE 1 – 7

(Refer to the photographs on the last page)

1. School uniform (Girls)

Summer:

- Dark green dress with school badge on the left-hand side
- Plain white, open-necked, short-sleeved shirt
- Dark green pullover (sleeveless v-neck with badge on left-hand side) - optional
- Dark green v-neck jersey with badge on left-hand side
- White socks (ankle high and folded over / no anklets or secret socks allowed)
- Black shoes

Winter:

- Dark green dress OR long grey pants (girls' style) with a zip on the side
- Plain white, open-necked, short or long-sleeved shirt (no tie)
- Dark green pullover (sleeveless v-neck with badge on left-hand side) - optional
- Dark green v-neck jersey with badge on left-hand side
- Green winter jacket with badge on left-hand side
- Black pantyhose or long grey socks
- Black shoes

2. Sportswear (girls)

- Athletics: Green athletics shorts, athletics vest
- Hockey: Green skirt with hot pants, green and yellow shirt, green socks with yellow stripes
- Netball: Green skirt with hot pants, green and yellow shirt, white socks
- Swimming: Black racer back swimming costume or green school costume, green or black swimming cap, (Green skirt with hot pants, green and yellow shirt, white socks)
- Tennis: Green skirt with hot pants, green and yellow shirt, white socks
- Phys Ed: Green skirt with hot pants, green and yellow shirt, white socks
- Cross Country: Green shorts, athletics vest
- ★ Grade 1 - Grade 3 girls wear green shorts instead of green skirts.

All sport

- Official school tracksuit
- Takkies must be predominantly white, grey or black.
- Socks to be ankle high and folded over; no anklets or secret socks allowed
- Green panties must be worn with school dress and sport uniform.

3. School uniform (Boys)

Summer:

- Plain white, short-sleeved, open-necked shirt with badge on left-hand side
- Short grey trousers
- Dark green pullover (sleeveless v-neck with badge on left-hand side) - optional
- Dark green v-neck jersey with badge on left-hand side
- Long grey socks
- Black shoes
- Only Grade Seven boys may wear long trousers in summer.

Winter:

- Plain white, open-necked, short or long-sleeved shirt (with school badge on left-hand side)
- Short or long grey trousers
- Dark green pullover (sleeveless v-neck with badge on left-hand side) -optional
- Dark green v-neck jersey with badge on left-hand side
- Green winter jacket with badge on left-hand side
- Long grey socks
- Black shoes

4. Sportswear (Boys)

- Athletics: Green athletic shorts and vest
- Hockey: Green shorts, green and yellow shirt, green socks with yellow stripes
- Tennis: Green shorts, green and yellow shirt, white socks
- Rugby: Black shorts, rugby jersey
- Mini Cricket: Green shorts, green and yellow shirt, green socks with yellow stripes
- Cricket: Green shorts, green and yellow shirt, green socks with yellow stripes, white wide-brimmed cricket hat (to be purchased at any outlet)
- Swimming: Black jammer costume or green school costume, black or green swimming cap

- Cross country: Green shorts, athletics vest
- Phys Ed: Green shorts, green and yellow shirt, white socks (no anklets or secret socks allowed)

All Sport

- All sport: Official school tracksuit
- Takkies must be predominantly white, grey or black.

Very Important

- Sport and school uniform may not be mixed. The green school jersey may not be worn with the sports uniform and the tracksuit top may not be worn with the school uniform.
- Sport socks with logos such as Adidas, Nike, etc. may NOT be worn; only white socks.
- Socks must be ankle length and turned over. No anklets or secret socks allowed.
- Only Kenridge suitcases are allowed.

5. Hair

Girls:

- Must be clean, natural and neat in style and will be subject to acceptable norms, set by the school.
- Fringes should not hang in the eyes. Should the fringe hang over the eyebrows, it must be cut or fastened back with clips. (Educators will use their professional judgment in this regard.)
- Hair touching the collar must be tied up.
- Long hair must be neatly tied up/back. Only one or two ponytails allowed. No side ponytails. Neat ballet buns allowed.
- Long hair may not be tied with a decorative clip - no large bulldog/butterfly clips.
- No perming or hi-lighting of the hair permitted - gel/hairspray may be used in moderation.
- Only green, white or black ribbons, elastics, alic bands, scrunchies and clips are allowed. Hair bands should not be decorative or wider than 4½cm. No brown or fancy hair accessories are allowed.

Boys:

- Must be clean, short, neat and natural in colour.
- The top should be thinned out and evenly blended to the sides and back.
- A distinct, shaved line separating short and longer hair is not allowed.
- Long hair is not allowed.

- Hair may not touch the ears or shirt collar.
- No long fringes - fringe may not touch the eyebrows
- Gel/hairspray may be used in moderation.
- Hair may not be coloured, permed or highlighted.

6. Nails

- Nails must be kept short
- No nail varnish on finger or toenails is allowed.

7. Jewellery

Girls:

- The wearing of jewellery as part of a religious faith, practised by a learner, is allowed and a letter will be required to inform the school of this observance.
- A plain watch may be worn - No charm bracelet type of watch is allowed. Watch straps may not be bright/ luminous colours. Medic Alert bracelets permitted.
- Earrings: only 1 pair of small, plain gold or silver studs may be worn - one earring in each earlobe. No studs with precious stones, and no sleepers are allowed.
- No chains, rings or armbands are allowed.

Boys:

- Only plain watches and Medic Alert bracelets are allowed.
- Watch straps may not be bright/ luminous colours.

8. Muslim Learners

- Muslim learners are allowed to add the following items to their school uniform:
 - Long sleeve white shirt in summer.
 - Black scarf
 - Black stockings in summer (no black leggings allowed).

9. Civvies

- Parents must check that their children are dressed appropriately for civvies days, before leaving home.
- Learners should wear neat, presentable clothes. Beachwear and tight-fitting clothes that are see-through and/or revealing are not allowed.
- The hair and jewellery rules for school uniform, also apply on civvies days.
- Skirts, dresses and shorts may not be very short.
- Footwear is compulsory.

NOTE: Only learners who have applied, submitted relevant documentation and received the necessary permission from the School Governing Body may deviate from the official school uniform for religious and cultural reasons as contemplated.

The Governing Body and / or the school reserve the right to amend this document at any time, provided that the changes remain within the ambit of the original document.
